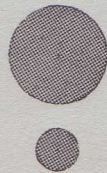
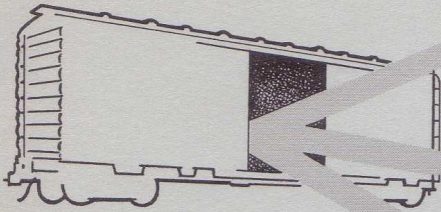

WHAT IS TRANSLOADING?

Transloading is a service offered by the Frisco Railway at Memphis, Tennessee and Springfield, Missouri, to carload shippers, for which no charge is made other than applicable stopping-in-transit charges.

You can request transloading when you have a carload of packaged freight with stops to partly unload, and when stops via route of movement are authorized.

The most important factor that must be observed, and that we feel should be stressed, is that your stops be authorized. By "authorized" we mean that your stops be permitted and are actually or constructively intermediate by tariff provisions.

In addition to developing if stops are authorized, you should determine under what conditions you are allowed more than one stop to partly unload at the same station.

If you will contact our office in your area, listing of which is shown herein, we will determine that for you. Once that is done, you can request transloading and let us do the rest.

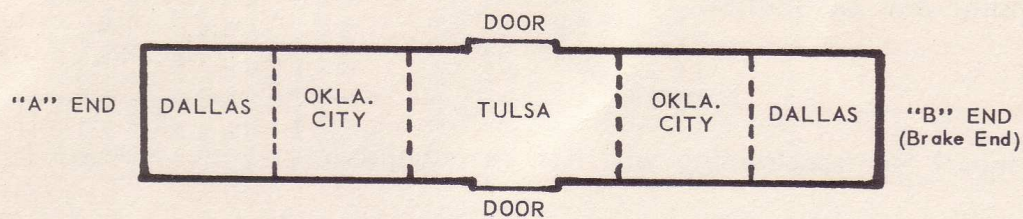
Your request will be complied with when articles or packages to be transloaded are so loaded in the inbound car as to be readily accessible, and when the bill of lading and shipping instructions show the number of articles and packages, and weight thereof, to be transloaded and forwarded to named consignees at stop-off point and destination.

Request for transloading will not be accepted:

- A. On freight loaded in open cars.
- B. On freight which requires the use of special or mechanical devices other than ordinary platform vehicles, including fork lift trucks and devices.
- C. On perishable freight which requires protection against heat and is subject to rules, regulations and charges governing refrigeration service or services of icing and reicing as provided in Perishable Protective Tariff 17, Agent W. T. Jamison's I.C.C.34.

The advantages to you are that when your car arrives Memphis, Tennessee or Springfield, Missouri, it will be transferred into other cars. Your shipments will move from transloading point simultaneously in separate cars, one to each stop-off point, and one to final destination. Each of your customers receives his shipment at practically the same time.

To expedite handling, it is suggested that chart indicating loading, as shown below, accompany your instructions; also, that shipments be separated by bulkheads or paper dividers:

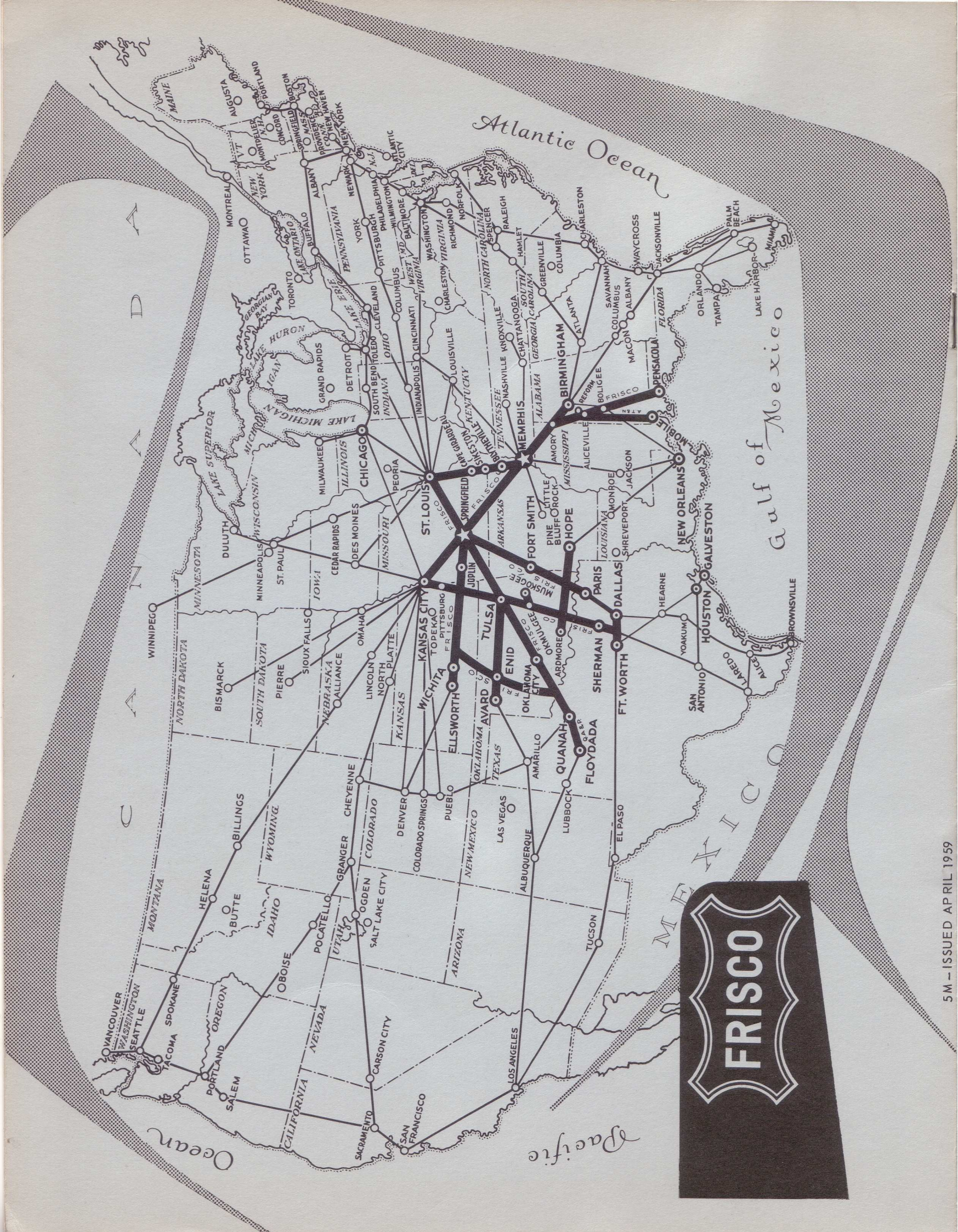
